Treasure Hunt

The 'Rhoscolyn Treasure Hunt' is a team challenge that aims to introduce people to the beautiful coastal idyll of Rhoscolyn. The treasure hunt can be undertaken as a fun event by a family or small group to simply add interest to an afternoon's walk. Alternatively, the more competitive can sign up for the '2008 Team Challenge' competing against the clock to set the highest score in the fastest time.

Whichever option you choose, the Treasure Hunt will test your map and compass skills taking you to a range of local landmarks to answer a series of questions. Groups will need to plan their own route making use of public rights of way. Completing the Treasure Hunt can take between 2-3 hours depending on the speed of the group. It is recommended that children under 14 are accompanied by an adult.

Treasure Hunt - independent option

If you just want to take part for the fun of it, you can rent a Treasure Hunt Pack for the day. This will provide you with the clues, a set of rules (if you want them), a local area map and compass. You could have your own competition, setting teams and racing against each other.

2008 Team Challenge

Teams will be briefed and compete against the clock. Andy Short will arrange the timing for all Team Challenge events.
